

If you receive a visit, we will check that you have the required documentation for the CE marking. The visits will take place in August and September 2014.

If you are not one to receive a visit, we will contact you in October to ask your opinion about the information campaign.

Nails and screws
for gypsum
plasterboard and
timber constructions
must be CE marked



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If you are a retailer, manufacturer/producer or importer of nails and screws, you should pay attention to the rules for CE marking.

Nails and screws for gypsum plasterboards must be CE marked, if they are covered by the standard EN 14566:2008+A1:2009 *Mechanical fasteners for gypsum plasterboard systems – Definitions, requirements and test methods*

Nails and screws for timber structures must be CE marked, if they are covered by the standard EN 14592:2008+A1:2012 *Timber structures – Dowel-type fasteners – Requirements*

As part of the market surveillance, we will visit selected manufacturers/producers, retailers and importers.

The purpose of the market surveillance is to ensure that all construction products marketed, sold and used in Denmark are safe and not detrimental to health, and are traded in a market of fair competition.

As a **distributor/retailer** you should make sure:

- That the construction product is CE marked
- That a declaration of performance has been prepared
- That instructions for use/information on the packaging have been prepared
- That CE marking, a declaration of performance and instructions for use accompany the construction product
- That you assist the authorities in connection with market surveillance.

As a **manufacturer/producer** or **importer** you are responsible for:

- The technical documentation, e.g. determination of product characteristics
- The CE marking
- The declaration of performance
- The instructions for use.
